## Paradise Point Awarded as Recycler of the Year



The City of San Diego recently named Paradise Point as Recycler of the Year. The hotel was awarded at the 22nd Annual Waste Reduction & Recycling Awards on April 29 aboard the USS Makin Island. 

Paradise Point's recycling practices include the use of refillable dispensers for guest amenities to eliminate individual packaging waste, paperless purchase order procedures, an electric car sharing program and a waste management system. The waste management system began in 2013 and has since helped increase the property's waste diversion rate from 10 percent to 68 percent through recycling and the composting of food scraps and landscape debris.

Paradise Point's recycling efforts are part of a larger island-wide eco initiative called Destination Earth. The sustainability program earned the hotel an official partnership and recognition from the Surfrider Foundation, an organization that works to protect the world's oceans, beaches and waterways.

Paradise Point is a AAA Four Diamond hotel located on a 44-acre private island with more than 65,000 square feet of bayside meeting and event space. The hotel features 462 bungalow-style rooms, a full-service conference center, 30 meeting rooms and eight executive boardrooms.
