Paradise Point Resort & Spa's signature restaurant Baleen has reopened as **Tidal** . The eatery's first remodel since 1999 has transformed the dated, dark space into a light-filled modern beach house with sweeping views of Mission Bay.

At the helm is chef **Amy Dibiase**, who worked at Baleen from 2006 to 2008 and [returned to the resort last year](#).

Dibiase had input in the restaurant's new design, which she says is a better complement to her style of food. Tidal's new menu, which **fully launches on Thursday**, prominently features local ingredients, from seafood and produce to Con Pane bread and a cheese program powered by Venissimo.

[Snake Oil Cocktail Company](#) consulted on the cocktail list, lending their culinary sensibilities to drinks including the Monkey See, Monkey Do, a mix of rum, smashed banana, muddled cilantro, dandelion and burdock bitters, orange and honey soda

Tidal will start **Saturday and Sunday brunch service** over Easter weekend and plans to introduce a happy hour worthy of enticing locals soon.
